

DUKE REALTY FASHIONS ON THE FIELD 2023 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Duke Realty Fashions on the Field (FOTF) is open to entrants aged 18 years and over.

2. FOTF entrants are not permitted to receive a commercial benefit from appearing in the competition.

3. FOTF entrants must not receive any payment from a third party (including any commercial enterprise) for entering, participating in, or otherwise in connection with the competition.

4. FOTF entrants may only enter this competition in their own private capacity and not on behalf of a third party, including commercial enterprise, designer or milliner. A collaboration with a third party is permitted only for the new FOTF award to be judged on Channel 7 Oaks Day for an Emerging Designer.

5. FOTF entrants must register their details on the day at a FOTF Registration Desk to enter the competition and be allocated an entrant number and paddle.

6. FOTF entrants who fail to register in time or are not present in time to enter the competition judging will be disqualified from the competition and their entry deemed invalid.

7. Judging will be undertaken by a minimum of three panellists each day of the competition, and winners chosen by a tally of votes from the Judges' absolute discretion.

8. The Judges' decision as determined by the number of votes is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

9. FOTF prizes on three racedays, Ladbrokes Derby Day, Channel 7 Oaks Day, and The Star Stradbroke Day, will be awarded to entrants in 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. An additional prize in the category of Emerging Designer will be made on Channel 7 Oaks Day.

10. All prize winners will be notified immediately, announced on stage, and be presented with their prizes.



11. Judges are briefed to select winners according to:

- Appropriateness for winter racewear tradition (elegant, sophisticated, seasonally-suited with winter fabrications and no straw or sinamay millinery)
- Style and originality
- Head-to-toe detail (accessories and grooming are taken into consideration)
- o Understanding of current fashion trends
- Overall presentation and personality

12. To enter in the Emerging Designer category, FOTF entrants must have either made their own outfit and millinery or collaborated with an Emerging Designer to create their look.

13. Emerging Designers are defined as students, recent graduates or new practitioners operating a business of under 5 employees.

14. Brisbane Racing Club (BRC) takes no responsibility for any cancellations, delays, postponements or any changes to the schedule of FOTF.

15. FOTF entrants must not in any way disparage or make derogatory comments in any form (whether verbally, electronically or otherwise) about the Promoter, any competition associated with the FOTF competition or other contestants at any time.

16. FOTF entrants must not display any antisocial or disruptive behaviour including heckling or otherwise interrupting the competition.

17. FOTF entrants must not alter or add to their outfit in any way during the heats or the final of the competition.

18. FOTF prizes awarded are not transferable, exchangeable or redeemable for cash.

19. Travel and accommodation FOTF prizes are subject to terms and conditions.

20. BRC staff or their immediate family are not eligible to participate in the competition.



21. BRC accepts no responsibility for any accident, loss, injury or damage to any individual or property arising out of or in connection with the FOTF competition or the competition prizes, either during or after the competition.
22. Winners must collect their FOTF prizing on the day on which it was won or arrange for collection from the Eagle Farm Racecourse Administration office. (Address: 230 Lancaster Road, Ascot QLD). Collection must take place within 7 working days. Failure to collect prizing within 7 working days will result in the prize winner forfeiting the prize/s.

23. If an entrant is in breach of any of these terms and conditions, the Promoter may (at its absolute discretion) disqualify the entrant from the BRC's FOTF competition and/or any other FOTF competition.
