RACING NEWS

With Eagle Farm bedded down and performing splendidly, it's time to begin looking at how the 2019 Brisbane Racing Carnival might shape up.

Pleasingly Racing Queensland has directed some of the recent State Government's extra funding for the racing industry into a stakes boost for several of the BRC feature winter events. Tony Gollan's explosive sprinter Zoustyle, if he remains injury-free, is set for a big challenge this winter. With some natural development with maturity he could even measure up to the TAB Doomben 10,000 under weight-for-age conditions.

The high rating TAB Doomben 10,000, now rated in the top 10 races in Australia, has been granted a \$100,000 prizemoney hike to \$800,000.

The two-year-old program has been enhanced by doubling the Sires Produce Stakes to \$400,000, the Bill Carter Stakes from \$100,000 to \$200,000 and the Champagne Classic from \$175,000 to \$200,000.

The connections of stayers no doubt will be lured by a bigger financial carrot with the O'Shea Stakes doubled to \$400,000 and the Lexus Brisbane Cup also up by \$100,000 to \$400,000.

The just completed Summer Racing Carnival has provided some interesting form lines and time to judge just which Queensland-based horses are capable of being genuine Winter Carnival prospects.

It appears the three-year-old crop are the state's best chance of holding some of the big money away from those interstate and New Zealand raiders. Boomsara and Outback Barbie, first and third in a tense finish in the Magic Millions Guineas, can match the visiting three-year-olds and might even be able to step up against older opposition.

In the staying division Trusty Lad and A Man To Match are on target for the Queensland Derby. Both are untapped talents but have shown enough to be mentioned as prime Derby hopes.

Trusty Lad in particular had strong summer form even though he physically looked far short of his best. With extra condition he could be a much tougher opponent.

The Kiwis might be back in bigger numbers this winter with Eagle Farm back in action. They believe the longer straight at headquarters best suits the usual racing pattern of New Zealand horses.

MEMBER PROFILE SID MCDONNELL

Enthusiastic BRC member Sid McDonnell recently retired from the workforce but he's as busy as ever.

McDonnell who rarely misses a BRC Saturday meeting at Eagle Farm and Doomben is the quintessential fair dinkum Aussie bloke. He loves a beer, sport of any kind and a bet.

He spent over 40 years in a foreman role with Q Build but now has time to devote to checking the betting markets and his wife and 4 adult children.

While he passionately follows English soccer, Sid is a proud Queenslander and regularly attends football matches including the Roar, Lions and Broncos. He's a regular punter on sporting matches too.

But his favourite time of the week is Saturday afternoon when he and good mate Steve Dunne take block at a table in the Falvelon Bar (Doomben) or Derby Bar (Eagle Farm) and get set with a beer to swap tips for the day and work out their punting strategy.

"I started coming to the races with my parents when I was in Grade 5 at Toowong School," Sid explained.

"My mum would put on my bets. Every Saturday morning the radio would be on and we'd get the scratchings and the tips. Pretty much the same now."

McDonnell vividly remembers the glory days of Brisbane racing when Charlton Boy and Bengalla Lad had regular head-to-head battles and visiting stars Rajah Sahib and Triton were crowd pullers to carnival days nearly fifty years ago.

He has dabbled in sharing in the ownership of a few racehorses and enjoyed some wins with Final Demand, trained by now Racing Queensland steward Neil Boyle.

When he does have some rare spare time Sid and a few mates take a boat out to Rous Channel off Waterloo Bay to throw in a line.

"I catch fish at about the same rate I back winners," he joked.
