As the leading metropolitan race club in Queensland, the Brisbane Racing Club conducts 98 race meetings and hosts over 200,000 patrons each year.

The Brisbane Racing Club (BRC) was formed on 1 July 2009 - the result of a merger between the Queensland Turf Club (QTC) and the Brisbane Turf Club (BTC). The amalgamation of the former two clubs was the first of its kind for the Australian Racing Industry.

Racing began on the Eagle Farm site in 1865 and the Doomben site in the 1930's, with the finest thoroughbreds in Australasia having graced these historic courses.

The Brisbane Racing Club, in association with the Thoroughbred Racing History Association Inc., have created a dedicated heritage unit with a brief to preserve the history of thoroughbred horse-racing in Queensland.
