The Brisbane Racing Club occupies over 85 hectares of land across two racecourses, two sports clubs, a shopping centre, and a residential apartment complex. We recognise that we have a significant environmental impact within the city of Brisbane. As an organisation that encompasses racing, hospitality, and commercial business streams, we understand the value in actively reducing our environmental impact. We have established a BRC Sustainability Working Group and we aim to encourage all 350 of our permanent and casual employees to contribute to our sustainability goals.
