

BRISBANE RACING CLUB – Conditions of Entry WIN \$500 TO SPEND AT THE RACES

The “**WIN \$500 TO SPEND AT THE RACES**” promotion commences at **Fri 17th May 2019, 12pm** and concludes with the prize draw at **Mon 20th May 2019, 5pm** (‘The promotional period’)

How to Enter

To enter the “**WIN \$500 TO SPEND AT THE RACES**” promotion Brisbane Racing Club customers must simply do one or more of the following during the promotional period:

1. **Purchase any ticket to KIRIN Stakes Day (Sat, 25 May 2019) before 5pm on Monday, 20th May 2019.**

One entry will be chosen at random from the total entries received. One (1) winning entry will be chosen to win **\$500AUD cash**.

Number of entries

There will be no restrictions on the total number of entries in the promotion providing all entries are valid and received during the promotional period.

Conditions of Entry
